

Can FirstBit Software run on Linux?

Yes, FirstBit Software **can work on Linux**, depending on the deployment type and licensing requirements.

Below is an overview of supported scenarios and important limitations.

1. Working with cloud databases

If the database is hosted in the **FirstBit cloud**, Linux can be used as a client operating system without major limitations.

Desktop client on Linux

If only the **client application** is required on Linux (without deploying the server), a Linux client distributive can be provided upon request.

Key details:

- Licensing is handled through the **FirstBit licensing server**.
- Installation is typically performed through the graphical interface.
- Setup instructions can be provided if needed.
- The Linux client configuration is identical to the Windows version.
- The user interface and functionality remain the same as on Windows.

Browser access to cloud databases

If users access the cloud database through a web browser, there is **no functional difference between Linux and Windows**.

In this case:

- No OS-specific limitations are expected.
 - The system should operate normally through the browser interface.

2. Working with client self-hosted databases

For **self-hosted client databases**, Linux is currently **not supported** for certain FirstBit products.

This limitation applies because the **FirstBIT Licensing Center**, which is required for solutions such as:

- FirstBIT ERP
- FirstBIT Accounting
- FirstBIT Contracting

is not available for Linux.

As a result:

- The **1C platform itself can run on Linux**.
 - However, **FirstBIT solutions that depend on the Licensing Center cannot be fully deployed or operated in this environment**.

For Linux deployments, compatibility should be evaluated based on the database hosting model and licensing requirements.
